The purpose of this petition under the First Amendment (see, *Hartman v. Moore*, 547 U.S. 250 (2006)), is to put the foregoing public officials on notice that on September 24, 2024, a Federal Judge ruled that “water fluoridation . . . presents an unreasonable risk of injury to health,” specifically, “an unreasonable risk of reduced IQ in children.” *Food & Water Watch, Inc. v. U. S. EPA*, 17-CV-02162-EMC (N. D. California, Judge Edward Chen presiding).

As of today, you are all, in my opinion, directly or *indirectly* responsible for the continued injection of the toxic chemical fluoride into our County’s water supply, and are now on notice that **YOU** have a moral and/or legal obligation to do all that you can to ensure that the toxic chemical fluoride is **immediately** removed from the water supply in Erie County including in the City of Buffalo.
