Change Order No. 1

Attached is Change Order No. 1 pertaining to the above referenced contract. The Change Order is for time extension only.

Modification 001, Extension of Substantial Completion Time, includes extending Substantial Completion time from 11/22/24 to 12/20/24 while Final Completion will remain at 6/7/25.

Additional time is requested regarding conflict between existing underground utilities and a new catch basin. The basin is required to comply with Ten State Recommended Standards for Water Works and State Department of Health requirements.

The new basin was part of the contract documents. During construction in late October 2024, it was discovered that existing underground utilities were located in an area where a new catch basin was to be installed. The catch basin could not be obtained from concrete manufacturer until utilities were exposed and determined if changes to design of catch basin were needed. After utilities were exposed, the Engineering Consultant revised catch basin design in early November 2024 for which the Contractor then ordered new catch basin. In late November 2024, the concrete manufacturer notified Contractor that the catch basin would not be ready until early December 2024.

The Contractor anticipates installing the catch basin mid-December and project completion soon thereafter.

The Contractor, Amstar of Western New York (Amstar), for ECWA Project No. 202300060, Contract No. W-035B Storage Tank Refurbishing – Sandridge has submitted a request for a Substantial Completion Time Extension. The original Substantial Completion date per the contract was November 22, 2024. The Contractor has proposed a new Substantial Completion date of December 20, 2024. As defined by Section 01131 Schedule of Completion, 1.04 Substantial and Final Completion, A, Substantial Completion includes the following:

- 1. All Miscellaneous Modifications
- 2. All surface preparation and application of coating systems
- 3. Curing of coatings
- 4. Tank disinfection and filling
- 5. Testing and Health Department Approval
- 6. Tank ready for service

The Contractor has requested the time extension for the Substantial Completion Date for the following reason: When the Contractor began excavation for the overflow catch basin, the existing fill line and drain line alignments differed in the field versus the reference documents. The ECWA was on-site with the Contractor on October 31, 2024 to expose the fill line and drain line. A redesign was required to accommodate the drain line connection into the new catch basin. The finalized redesign was provided to the Contractor on November 6, 2024. On November 21, 2024, the Contractor was notified by the catch basin manufacturer that due to production issues, the redesigned catch basin would not be delivered until December 9, 2024. The Contractor's proposed schedule includes returning the tank to service by December 6, 2024 and completing all miscellaneous modifications except final restoration by December 20, 2024.

We recommend that the ECWA grant the time extension request and not enforce liquidated damages for the following reasons.

- The time extension is related to an unanticipated field condition.
- The Contractor has maintained open communication with the Engineer and the Owner related to site conditions and delays related to this work.
- The Contractor has continued to push forward with the work to get the tank returned to service by December 6, 2024 and allow the ECWA to return to normal operations as soon as possible.
- The delay does not result in a direct capital cost to the ECWA.

As you know once Amstar began excavating to verify the exact location of the existing fill line and drain line for the installation of the overflow catch basin, we discovered that those existing lines were not exactly where the plans thought they should be. This meant the exact location of the catch basin had to be relocated and the catch basin itself redesigned to accept the drain line connection at an angle.

On 11-21-24, I received an email from Kistner Concrete explaining that due to production issues the catch basin that had to be redesigned may not be ready for pick up until December 9th. We need time for installation and to temporarily cold patch the blacktop until the spring when it can be properly repaired. Therefore, Amstar is requesting a substantial completion date extension to December 20, 2024.



Good Morning Seth.

I just spoke with Cati and Bruce Cozad. Both are good with the schedule below if this works for ECWA. We could disinfect this week, but then the water will be sitting there longer waiting for testing with the Thanksgiving holiday, so I recommend we wait until next week.

- 1. Mon, Dec 2 chlorinate first thing and start filling after that. ECWA feels they can fill the tank in 24 to 28 hours.
- 2. Tues, Dec 3 morning take first sample once tank is confirmed to be full
- 3. Wed, Dec 4 morning take second sample + VOC sample
- 4. Fri, Dec 6 hopefully receive results and send to DOH for their review and verbal approval; put tank back on line in the afternoon.

For the overflow, the Duckbill check valve is being installed this week. Cati is going to work with the Amstar crew to install a temporary diversion of any overflow water so that it bridges the excavation. Likely some combination of plywood and bracing.

Let us know if above is acceptable to ECWA. Thanks.
