WATER AUTHORITY SPONSORS CIVIL SERVICE TRAINING FOR MINORITIES

BUFFALO, NEW YORK – The Erie County Water Authority (ECWA) is sponsoring a pre-civil service exam-training program targeting minorities. The training, which will be conducted by Erie Community College's Department of Workforce Development, is designed to better prepare minorities for civil service job opportunities at the ECWA.

The training session will be for the positions of Construction Inspector and Hydrant Valve Crew Chief and will be held on Thursday, December 18, 2003, from 6 p.m.-9 p.m. at ECC's City Campus room 420. The class allows a maximum of 30 pupils, and participants must submit a civil service exam application prior to registering for the training session. The civil service exams for both positions will be held on January 10, 2004. The application-filing deadline is December 3 for Construction Inspector and December 17 for Hydrant Valve Crew Chief.
